We have a new Facility and Transportation Manager who comes to NCSI ready and qualified to make beneficial changes. His name is Harrison Smith. We welcome him with open arms.

In-Person instruction is off and running and the students are profiting from the smaller class sizes and the differentiated instruction provided by their teachers. They are also happy to see their friends again.
