Message from New Principal, Mr. Moore

I came to AZ back in 1980 from Greenwich CT. I lived in Phoenix area for 20 + years, teaching in a number of school districts throughout the Valley of the Sun.

In 2007 I accepted a principal’s position in a small remote Reservation town named Hard Rock, AZ. I ran Rocky Ridge Boarding School for 5 years; in retrospect it was some of the best times I’ve had as an administrator. I learned a lot and developed some beautiful relationships there.

I left Rocky Ridge Boarding School and worked at Moencopi Day School which housed Hopi and Navajo students. Again, I found myself in love with the student population and the dedicated teachers who made me feel welcomed.

I went to Window Rock School District afterward and became the principal of their Middle School. It was challenging and I worked really hard to gain the respect of the students, parents and teachers. They still talk, favorably about me to this day.

My latest stop on my Reservation journey was Chinle Unified School District. I was the principal at Many Farms Public School. We had students from Pre-K thru 8th grade.

I look forward to greeting parents, teachers, students and community stakeholders of Nazlini Community School Inc. Together, we will create an institution of life-long learners.
